



A 5-DAY PRAYER GUIDE

Praying for God's Mission in Taiwan



Day 1 – Concordia Middle School

More than 2,000 Taiwanese students attend Concordia Middle School and Concordia English Language Academy. Pray for these students to have open hearts to hear the Gospel, for good relationships between Taiwanese and foreign teachers and between teachers and their students, and for more missionary teachers to serve in this ministry.

Day 2 – Churches

Pray for Taiwanese churches to be bold and winsome in their witness, faithful in their teaching and preaching, and Christ-like in caring both for members and those outside the church.

MCN Mission Partners

Some Mission Partners serve at Concordia Middle School in Chiayi, Taiwan where they teach English and Bible classes to Kindergarten through high school students. Other Mission Partners teach theology classes at China Lutheran Seminary in Hsinchu, Taiwan.

Day 3 – China Lutheran Seminary

China Lutheran Seminary teaches and trains lay people and full-time Chinese missionaries and church workers to be servants of the cross to spread the Gospel and nurture people in their faith. Pray for the teachers, staff, and students of CLS to be strengthened in their faith and filled with passion for spreading God's Word.

Day 4 – Families

Family relationships are central to Taiwanese life. Pray for harmony within marriages and between parents and children. Pray for Christians who are the only believers in their families to show Christ's love and be winsome witnesses to their family members.

Day 5 – Spiritual Warfare

A large majority of Taiwanese people follow a combination of Buddhism, Daoism, and traditional religion. There are temples on every street corner and most spiritual practice is based on fear. Pray for God's Spirit to conquer fear and for more and more Taiwanese to find freedom, peace, and security in Christ.
